**Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

**State Expenditure**

This bill adds Section 57-1-100 so as to provide that a highway construction projects approved by the Department of Transportation and certain appurtenances that are needed to construct the project are exempt from all local ordinances and laws that would otherwise require it to obtain local permits and zoning authorizations.

**Department of Transportation.** The proposed legislation could provide both a fiscal and time benefit to SCDOT. These benefits would vary based on the size and complexity of the projects and are difficult to quantify. SCDOT does not pay for local permits, but does comply with local ordinances such as noise.


