This bill requires local school districts to observe Martin Luther King, Jr. Day and Memorial Day as legal holidays beginning with the 2017-2018 school year. Schools and district offices must close on these dates. Districts may not schedule make-up days on these dates.

As school district calendars for 2017-2018 are not available for all districts, the number of districts that have scheduled school or make-up days for these holidays is unknown. Therefore, we expect an undetermined expenditure impact on school districts to republish existing school calendars and handbooks.
