State Expenditure

This bill requires that prior to and at the time the Department of Social Services (DSS) places a child with a relative providing kinship care, in a public or private residential facility, with a prospective adoptive parent, or with a foster parent the department shall disclose information necessary to provide adequate care and to protect the health and safety of the child.
