### **Fiscal Impact Summary**

The fiscal impact of this bill on the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) is pending, contingent upon a response from the agency.

### **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

#### **Introduced on February 21, 2019**

##### **State Expenditure**

This bill allows a utility task vehicle (UTV) with working headlights and rear brake lights to be operated along public streets and roadways of a barrier island that does not have highway access to the mainland or that may be accessed from the mainland solely by ferry or boat, provided that the owner of the vehicle has obtained a UTV permit decal or registration card from DMV. The decal or registration will be issued after proof of ownership and liability insurance is shown and with the payment of a \$5 fee. The fiscal impact of the bill is pending, contingent upon a response from DMV.
