This bill requires that any report that a state agency is required by law to present to the General Assembly, a standing committee, or other committees created by the General Assembly, must be electronically transmitted to LSA and the State Library. LSA and the State Library currently receive a significant number of state reports. This bill may increase the number of reports electronically transmitted but not by a significant amount. Both agencies anticipate being able to manage any additional electronically transmitted reports within existing appropriations. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact.
