Fiscal Impact Summary

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on January 16, 2018

State Expenditure

This bill provides language to conform all code sections with the provisions of Act 57 of 2017, which lowered the initial threshold for receiving the first two dealer license plates from twenty vehicles sold to fifteen.

The Department of Motor Vehicles indicates that they are currently conforming with the provisions of Act 57 of 2017 and are issuing dealer license plates under the new, lower threshold. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.
