**Fiscal Impact Summary**

**State Expenditure**

This bill makes changes as to who may sign the application for a license or identification card for an individual who is less than eighteen years of age as it relates to registration with the Selective Service System. In addition to the mother, father, and guardian, individuals who have custody of the minor, individuals with written approval by DSS, individuals who have been standing in loco parentis of a minor of not less than sixty days, or a responsible adult who is willing to assume the obligation and has written permission may sign the application. By signing the application, the signatory authorizes DMV to register the applicant with the Selective Service System upon attaining eighteen years of age, if required by federal law. Additionally, if the signatory declines the Selective Service System registration, DMV may issue a license or identification card, but the applicant must renew the license or identification card upon attaining eighteen years of age.

**Department of Motor Vehicles.** The department indicates that any expenses incurred as a result of revisions to forms and policies can be managed within current appropriations.

Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.

**Department of Social Services.** The department indicates that the provisions of this bill can be conducted in the normal course of agency business. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.
