Fiscal Impact Summary

The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) indicates that this bill will have no impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds since it requires the agency to perform activities that are currently conducted in the normal course of agency business.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on January 8, 2019

State Expenditure

This bill amends the code reference from crime of violence in Section 16-23-10(3) to violent crime in Section 16-1-60. In addition, the bill removes the requirement that DMV must issue by mail or in person a new license or special identification card with a code that identifies the person has been convicted of a violent crime, after receipt of a \$50 fee.

DMV indicates that the changes will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds since it requires the agency to perform activities that are currently conducted in the normal course of agency business. Further, the reference to a \$50 fee is not contained in the current Code of Laws.
