Fiscal Impact Summary

The amended bill will increase non-recurring General Fund expenses of the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) by \$15,000. The bill will have no expenditure impact on Other Funds or Federal Funds. This fiscal impact statement has been updated to include a response from DMV.

Updated for Additional Agency Response

State Expenditure

The amended bill requires DMV to designate a symbol to be placed on the driver's license or special identification card of an applicant who has been medically diagnosed with autism. DMV may place the symbol on the applicant's driver's license or special identification card only upon request by the applicant. The applicant must provide documentation that he is autistic from a physician licensed in this state.

Department of Motor Vehicles. The agency indicates that this bill will increase non-recurring expenses by \$15,000 for creation of the autism symbol, programming, system updates, and system testing. This section has been updated to include a response from DMV.
