State Expenditure

This bill establishes a fee for wild turkey transportation tags, amends the season for hunting male wild turkey, and decreases the bag limit for male wild turkeys. The bill further states that it is unlawful to take a female wild turkey, changes regulations regarding Youth Turkey Day, and requires fees collected for wild turkey transportation tags to be used for specific research and conservation purposes.

The expenditure impact of this bill is pending, contingent upon a response from DNR.
