Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill will have no impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds, as members of the committee shall serve without mileage, per diem, or subsistence.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on February 13, 2018

State Expenditure

This bill would create the South Carolina State Flag Study Committee, charged with proposing an official design for the state flag. The committee is chaired by the Director of the Department of Archives and History, or his designee. Additional members of the committee include: the Director of the Department of Administration or a designee, one member appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and one member appointed by the Governor. The committee shall provide their proposed design to the General Assembly by December 31, 2018, at which time the committee shall dissolve. The bill states that the members of the committee shall serve without mileage, per diem, or subsistence.

This bill creates a study committee with members whose expenses will be managed within the budgets of the members' respective agencies. The Department of Archives and History and the Department of Administration indicate that the bill will not impact the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.
