The Department of Motor Vehicles expects the expenditure impact of this bill to be minimal. Some additional costs are expected, but can be absorbed by the agency's Other Funds. There will be no impact on the General Fund or Federal Funds.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill provides that a moped must be registered, carry liability insurance, and may not be operated on a public road that has a speed limit greater than thirty-five miles an hour. It also provides that a person whose driver's license has been suspended may not be issued a moped operator's license or allowed to operate a moped during his period of suspension.

The Department of Motor Vehicles expects the expenditure impact of this bill to be minimal. Reprogramming costs are expected but can be absorbed by the agency's Other Funds.
