Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill will result in a savings for the Department of Transportation of \$66,000 per year in Other Funds. There will be no impact on the General Fund or Federal Funds.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill provides for the elimination of a seven-member commission as the governing body of the Department of Transportation (DOT) and alternately establishes the Secretary of Transportation as the authority for the agency. It also amends the section relating to the board of directors of the infrastructure bank to remove the chairman of the DOT, who will be replaced by the Secretary of Transportation. It allows for the Governor to appoint the Secretary of Transportation and requires the DOT to submit to the General Assembly an itemized project list to be funded for the fiscal year.

The Department of Transportation reports there will be a savings to their Other Funds of \$66,000 per year. There will be no impact on the General Fund or Federal Funds.
